Neutral and Earth: In a 2-pole breaker, the neutral may also be switched depending on the breaker type. For breakers with residual current protection (RCD), the protective earth (PE) must be connected to the ground busbar to ensure safety ().

- Residential:** 240V appliances such as air conditioners, water heaters, electric ovens, EV chargers, and subpanels ().
- Commercial/Industrial:** Heavy-duty equipment, HVAC systems, industrial machinery, and specialized outlets requiring full voltage ().

- Power-off Operation:** Always disconnect and lock out the main power before wiring ().
- Current Rating:** Ensure the breaker's rated current matches the load to prevent overloading ().
- Wire Specifications:** Use wires with appropriate cross-sectional area for the load; typically 2.5mm² for lighting and sockets, 4mm² for higher loads like AC units ().
- Secure Connections:** Terminals must be tightly fastened to avoid overheating or fire hazards ().
- Compliance:** Follow local electrical codes and standards for installation ().
