Connector boots are color-coded to indicate polish type: UPC (blue) or APC (green). Following this standardized color code reduces miswiring, simplifies splicing, and ensures global consistency across installations. By adhering to this scheme, technicians can efficiently manage high-density 288-fiber cables, whether in loose-tube, ribbon, or hybrid constructions, ensuring accurate identification and maintenance.
