

A 100m fiber optic wireless router is very slow

2. Update Router Firmware: Ensure your router firmware is up to date to fix bugs and improve performance.
3. Adjust Router Settings: Set WAN/LAN ports to 1 Gbps if supported. Disable QoS or parental controls temporarily to see if speed improves. Change Wi-Fi channel and width to reduce interference.
4. Optimize Placement: Place the router in a central, elevated location, away from thick walls and electronic devices.
5. Restart Devices: Power cycle your modem and router to clear temporary glitches.
6. Consider Upgrading Hardware: If your router is older or only supports 100 Mbps, upgrading to a gigabit-capable router will allow you to fully utilize...
