Grounding Requirements Each distribution box must be grounded to prevent electric shock and protect connected equipment. In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is typically used, while in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is standard . The grounding system should maintain a resistance of less than 0.1 Ohm between all system parts to ensure effective fault current dissipation .

Connection Points

- Box to Mounting Plate:** Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the distribution box to the mounting plate .
- Mounting Plate to Central Ground:** Connect a second ground wire from the mounting plate to the facility's central grounding point .
- Optional Spindle Grounding:** If tool cables or spindles are connected, additional grounding may be required. For long tool cables (>30 m) or multiple spindles, a 16 mm² (6 AWG in the US) wire from the mounting plate to the spindle plate ensures low resistance and proper grounding .

Best Practices

- Parallel Grounding:** Grounding points should be connected in parallel rather than in series to avoid a single point of failure .
- Clean Contact Surfaces:** Ensure all metal surfaces are free of oxidation, dirt, or rust to maintain conductivity .
- Check Resistance:** Measure ground resistance after installation, as soil conditions, moisture, and corrosion can affect performance .
- Separate Ground and Neutral:** In subpanels or secondary distribution boxes, keep the ground and neutral bars separate to prevent safety hazards .
