Choosing the Right Air Switch

General household switch: Use a double-pole 32-63A small air switch or isolation switch for the main supply.

Air conditioning circuits: 16-25A air switches, often on a separate circuit.

Phase configuration: Use bipolar or 1P+N (phase + neutral) switches to ensure both lines are disconnected during a fault. For three-phase circuits, confirm the incoming line is three-phase; otherwise, connect phase, neutral, and ground appropriately.

Installation Steps

Site Preparation: Turn off the main power supply and ensure the distribution box is accessible and free of moisture or debris.

Mounting the Air Switch: Secure the air switch in the designated slot of the distribution box. Ensure it is compatible with the box type and rated for the expected load.

Wiring Connections: Connect the phase wire to the input terminal of the air switch. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral terminal if using 1P+N or bipolar switches. Connect the ground wire to the distribution box or grounding terminal. For three-phase switches, connect each phase to its respective terminal and ensure proper grounding.

Circuit Segregation: Divide circuits logically: air conditioners, kitchen, and bathroom outlets on separate circuits; remaining outlets and lighting can be grouped depending on load.

Testing: After wiring, turn on the main supply and test each circuit for proper operation. Verify that the air switch trips correctly under simulated overload or short-circuit conditions.

Safety Considerations: Always cut off power before installation. Use switches rated for the sp...
