Check for Labels or Stamps: Manufacturers often mark trays with type information (GI, HDG, or pre-galvanized) or standards compliance (NEMA, IEC).

Environmental Consideration: If the basement is humid or prone to moisture, installers often choose hot-dip galvanized trays for better long-term protection.
