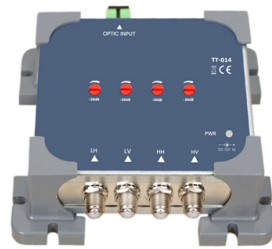


BIM cable tray color national standard

- Color by voltage or phase:** High-voltage vs low-voltage trays may be differentiated.
- Material-based color:** Galvanized steel, stainless steel, or PVC trays may be assigned different colors for clarity in models.

These colors are applied using materials, filters, or selection sets in Revit and Navisworks, ensuring that the visual representation is consistent across the project.

Practical Guidance

Follow project-specific BIM standards: Many organizations define their own color schemes in BIM execution plans.

Use consistent color coding: Even if not mandated nationally, consistent colors improve coordination and reduce errors during construction.

Reference manufacturer BIM objects: Companies like Metsec, ABB, and EAE Electric provide Revit families with default colors that can be customized to project standards.
