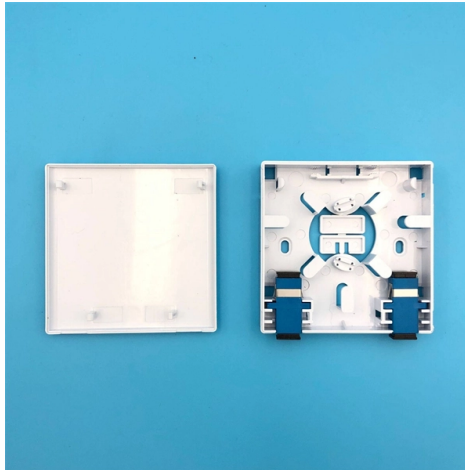


# Building Energy for Burkina Faso



## AI Overview

Energy efficiency in Burkina Faso's building sector is emerging as a critical strategy to manage growing electricity demand, with current efforts focused on regulations, rural electrification, and renewable energy integration.

**Current Energy Context** Burkina Faso faces increasing energy demand due to population growth and economic development, with electricity access rates at 50% nationally, 86% in urban areas, and only 5% in rural areas. The country benefits from abundant solar resources, averaging 5.5 kWh/m<sup>2</sup> daily for 3,000–3,500 hours per year, making solar energy a key component of building energy solutions. Despite progress in electrification and renewable energy deployment, challenges remain, including high equipment costs, security crises, and limited technical expertise.

**Energy Efficiency in Buildings** The building sector in Burkina Faso is energy-intensive, contributing significantly to national energy consumption. Current regulations aim to promote energy efficiency, but studies indicate that these measures have not yet achieved the desired impact. Key obstacles include: Inadequate or outdated regulations and standards Limited focus on residents' energy consumption habits Emphasis on building materials rather than operational energy use Energy efficiency strategies focus on reducing energy consumption while maintaining thermal comfort, which is particularly important in a hot climate where cooling and lighting demand can be high.

**Renewable Energy Integration** Renewable energy, particularly solar, is central to improving building energy performance. Initiatives include: Rooftop solar systems and net metering to supply electricity directly to buildings Solar home systems for rural electrification, supporting communities with limited grid access Bioenergy and small-scale hydropower for heating and electricity in buildings These measures aim to reduce reliance on fossil fuels, lower greenhouse gas emissions, and provide affordable, sustainable energy for both urban and rural buildings.
