Plastic and Fiberglass Cable Trays Plastic trays, typically made from PVC, are cost-effective, lightweight, and resistant to chemical exposure (). Fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) trays are used in highly corrosive environments, such as chemical plants or marine settings, due to their non-conductive and chemical-resistant properties (). Both options are suitable for light-duty applications and low-voltage cables but cannot support heavy industrial cables.

- Load Capacity:** Steel for heavy-duty, aluminum or plastic for lighter loads ().
