

Busbar Cable Tray Safety Regulations



Overview

The use and installation of cable trays is covered by legally enforceable OSHA regulations in 29 CFR 1910. Busway Installation is the process of hanging and connecting busway throughout a commercial or industrial facility. These conductors are usually copper or aluminum. Cables and busbar systems are the most common and reliable ways to do so, at least until wireless energy transport is developed :) However, many potential issues need to be addressed. This article deals with four significant precautions you should take – grouping conductors in parallel, short. All operatives will attend the Project Safety induction prior to commencing work on site. For systems with 110kV and above, where the neutral point is effectively grounded, the metal sheath of single-core cables should be directly connected to the substation grounding. BS 7671:2011+A3:2015 (IET Wiring Regulations Seventeenth Edition), which was published in January 2015 and comes into effect on 1 July, will include a requirement that wiring systems in escape routes shall have fire-resisting supports.
