

Cable Tray Hanger Bracket Installation Method

Ceiling suspension (trapeze or C-hanger) using threaded rods and channels for overhead mounting. Beam clamps for attaching to structural steel without drilling, which preserves the integrity of the building structure. Ensure the selected brackets are rated for the tray size and load, with typical single-hanger capacities ranging from 50 lbs for small trays to 700–750 lbs for larger ladder trays.

Installation Steps

- Drill and anchor:** For wall or ceiling mounting, drill holes and insert appropriate anchors (expansion bolts for concrete or drop-in anchors for ceilings).
- Attach threaded rods or channels:** For ceiling suspension, screw in threaded rods and attach a horizontal channel or Unistrut to create a shelf for the tray.
- Mount the bracket:** Slide the hanger bracket onto the rod or channel and secure with nuts and washers. Use lock nuts to prevent loosening due to vibration.
- Level the tray:** Ensure the tray is perfectly level before tightening all fasteners.
- Install the tray:** Place the cable tray onto the brackets, using couplers or splice plates for connecting sections. Ensure that splice joints fall between support points and not at...
