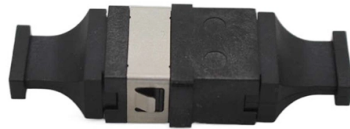


Cable tray and manhole installation

Support Installation: Install brackets, hangers, or supports along the route. Typical spacing is 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load.

Tray Placement: Align trays straight and level, connecting sections with appropriate fittings. For long runs, use cable tray rollers to prevent kinks and ensure smooth cable entry.

Manhole Entry: Ensure the tray enters the manhole at a safe angle, avoiding sharp bends. Use bends, elbows, or reducers as needed to maintain proper cable bend radius.

Cable Laying: Lay cables neatly within the tray, using ties or straps to separate by voltage and function. Leave slack for expansion or future adjustments.

Inspection and Testing: QA/QC inspectors should verify installation against approved drawings and standards. Check for proper alignment, secure connections, and compliance with safety requirements.
