- Channel Trays:** Narrow and compact, suitable for small cable quantities and control wiring. They reach fill limits quickly and are not ideal for large power cables.
- Wire Mesh/Basket Trays:** Lightweight, flexible, and ideal for data, telecom, and light power systems. They allow fast installation and field modifications.

- Support Spacing:** Recommended support locations are typically at 1/4 span of the tray length to minimize stress and deflection at splice points.
- Cable Fill:** Proper calculation of tray area is essential to prevent overcrowding, overheating, and inspection failures. Consider cable type, diameter, and quantity.
- Thermal Considerations:** Wider trays reduce heat buildup, and perforation patterns improve...
