Sizing Considerations

Cable Quantity and Diameter: The width of the distribution box must accommodate the total cross-sectional area of all cables. For ladder trays, the interior usable width should be at least equal to the sum of the individual cable diameters. For solid bottom trays, the sum of cable diameters should not exceed 90% of the tray width ().

Cable Fill Ratio: NEC specifies a 40% fill ratio for power cables and 50% for control cables, ensuring adequate ventilation and preventing overheating ().

Future Expansion: It is recommended to add 25% spare capacity to allow for future cable additions without overcrowding ().

Tray Type Compatibility: Distribution boxes must match the tray type—ladder, perforated, or solid bottom—as each type has different structural and ventilation characteristics ().

Depth and Material

Depth: The depth of the distribution box is typically aligned with the tray side rail height, ranging from 25mm to 150mm, to allow proper cable stacking and heat dissipation ().
