Cable Tray Types and Specifications

- Ladder Tray** Open structure with rungs for maximum ventilation and heat dissipation. Ideal for heavy power cables and long support spans. Material: Steel (galvanized, pre-galvanized, or stainless), aluminum, or fiberglass-reinforced polyester. Standard widths: 100–600 mm; side rail heights: 50–150 mm; rung spacing: 150–300 mm. - Perforated (Trough) Tray** Solid bottom with ventilation holes for moderate heat dissipation. Suitable for medium-weight cables and instrumentation/control wiring. Material: Steel, aluminum, or stainless steel. Provides continuous support while allowing airflow ().
- Channel Tray** U-shaped or C-shaped, often used for short runs or aesthetic applications. Can be ventilated or solid; protects against electromagnetic interference. Typically used for light instrumentation or control cables ().
- Wire Mesh Tray** Welded steel wire construction, lightweight and flexible. Ideal for light cables, data, and communication lines. Easy to cut and configure for complex routing ().

Material Considerations

Steel: High strength, can be hot-dip galvanized or pre-galvanized for corrosion resistance.

Stainless Steel (AISI 316L): Excellent corrosion resistance, suitable for harsh environments.

Aluminum: Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, suitable for indoor and outdoor use.

Fiberglass/Polyester: High resistance-to-weight ratio, corrosion-resistant, non-conductive ().
