- LAN-to-WAN Connection:** Connect the WAN port of the second router to a LAN port of the primary router. The primary router manages the internet connection and assigns IP addresses, while the second router can create a separate network segment.
- LAN-to-LAN Access Point Mode:** Configure the second router as an access point by connecting its LAN port to the primary router's LAN port, disabling DHCP on the second router, and assigning it a static IP within the same subnet. This extends Wi-Fi coverage without creating a separate network.
- Mesh-Like Setup:** Two routers can share the same SSID for seamless roaming, but they must operate on different channels to avoid interference, and security settings should match.

Placement and Configuration Tips

- Place the primary router centrally for optimal coverage.
- Position the secondary router where the primary signal is strong but coverage is weak.
- Use Ethernet cables (CAT5E or higher) for stable connections between routers.
- Avoid double NAT issues by disabling DHCP on the secondary router if it's in access point mode.
- Test speeds and coverage after setup to ensure optimal performance.
