

Can a drop cable be spliced with an optical fiber cable



Overview

This drop cable requires splicing at both ends. In the last few years, more systems have used pre-terminated round drop cables. ODN is a completely passive optical network, which is composed of optical cables, optical distribution boxes, optical closures, optical splitters, etc. Drop cables are often only 2-12 fibers, meaning most fibers are continuing. When deploying a FTTH network, subscribers must choose the right drop cable interconnect solution. The connectors terminated at both ends can be of the same type (LC-LC or SC-SC) or can be of different types (LC-SC) basis the application. A: Generally, the cable shall be bent no less than 20 times the diameter for installation and 10 times for static use.
