- Non-Metallic Conduits:** Using non-metallic conduits for fiber prevents grounding or voltage leakage from nearby power cables.
- Hybrid Cables:** Utilities often use specialized cables like Optical Power Ground Wire (OPGW), Optical Power Phase Conductor (OPPC), or Optical Power Attached Cable (OPAC), which integrate fiber and metallic conductors safely within a single cable designed for co-installation with power lines. These cables are engineered to withstand mechanical stress, temperature extremes, and outdoor conditions.

**Utility Applications** Electrical utilities frequently install fiber along transmission and distribution towers, sometimes sharing poles with power lines. OPGW and OPPC cables place optical fibers in a sealed metal tube surrounded by steel and aluminum conductors, ensuring the fibers are protect...
