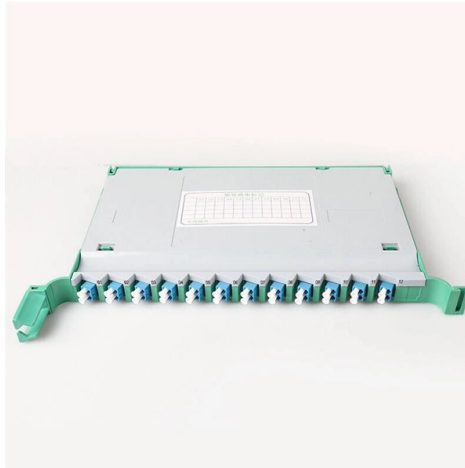


Can fiber optic cables be directly connected to patch cords Wireless



Overview
