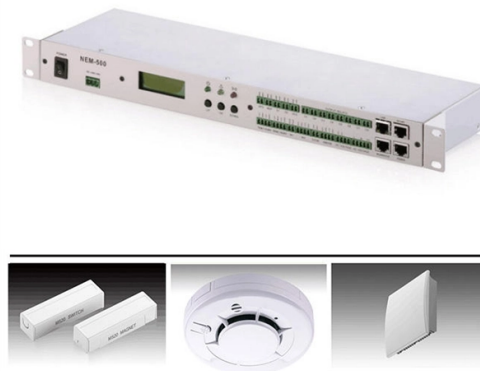

- Immunity to interference: Fiber is unaffected by electromagnetic or radio frequency interference, allowing safe installation near power lines and appliances.
- Future-proofing: Fiber supports emerging technologies like 4K/8K streaming, virtual reality, and large cloud data transfers.

- Fiber-optic cable: Ultra-thin glass strands carrying data as light pulses.
- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts fiber signals to electrical signals for your home network.
- Router or gateway: Distributes internet to devices; modern routers supporting Wi-Fi 6 or higher are recommended.
