How Fiber Internet Connects to a Router

Equipment Needed

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** Converts fiber signals to Ethernet. Often provided by the ISP.
- Fiber-ready or compatible router:** Ensures high-speed data transfer and Wi-Fi distribution. Look for routers supporting gigabit speeds or GPON compatibility.
- Fiber optic cable:** Connects the wall outlet to the ONT.
- Ethernet cable:** Connects the ONT to the router's WAN port.

Setting Up the Connection

- Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet to the ONT.
- Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize.
- Connect the ONT to your router using an Ethernet cable.
- Power on the router and configure it via its admin panel if necessary, entering ISP credentials.
- Verify internet access by connecting a device via Wi-Fi or Ethernet and running a speed test.

Wi-Fi Considerations

Fiber service itself does not broadcast Wi-Fi. The router connected to the ONT is responsible for creating your home Wi-Fi network. Many ISPs provide an all-in-one ONT/router unit, but if not, you can use your own compatible router to distribute Wi-Fi throughout your home.

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While the ONT is necessary for converting the fiber optic signal, you will still need a router to distribute the internet connection to multiple devices
