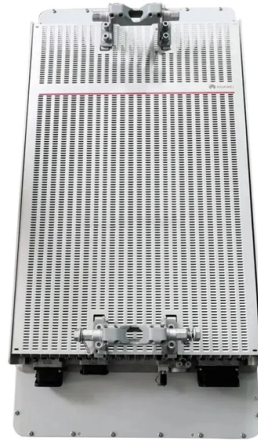

Using Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM) on Meraki Switches

Navigate to **Switching > Monitor > Switches** in the Meraki dashboard and select the switch. Click the **Ports** tab and select an operational SFP fiber port. The **Status** section displays DOM metrics: transmit power, receive power, temperature, voltage, and laser bias current. Historical data can be viewed in charts, showing median, max, and min values for each metric. Alerts are generated if thresholds are exceeded. DOM metrics are automatically enabled on switches running MS 17+ firmware and are polled every 5 minutes.

Physical Inspection and Connectivity Verification

Ensure fiber connectors are clean, properly inserted, and free of damage or debris. Verify that fiber cables are securely connected to the correct ports. Use a fiber optic power meter or OTDR to measure optical power levels and detect faults if the link is down.
