Connector and Jacket Color Coding Single-mode fibers (OS2): Yellow jacket, blue connector (UPC) or green connector (APC) for angled polish . Multimode fibers (OM3/OM4): Aqua jacket and connector. Older multimode may use orange or beige jackets . Outdoor cables: Typically black jackets for UV resistance; fiber identification relies on printed legends . Special Notes For 16-fiber MPO connectors, fibers 13-16 may use Olive, Magenta, Tan, Lime colors, following European or high-density ribbon standards . Using the standardized color sequence reduces errors, speeds installation, and ensures compatibility across different manufacturers and network operators . By following this color coding, technicians working on China Unicom optical networks can reliably identify fibers, manage splices, and maintain network integrity.
