- Earth/Ground Bars (PE):** Provide a safe path for fault currents to dissipate into the ground, protecting equipment and personnel.
- Branch Circuit Breakers:** Protect individual circuits, such as lighting, sockets, or motors, by interrupting power during overloads or faults.
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs/RCCBs):** Detect leakage currents and disconnect power to prevent electric shocks.
- Surge Protective Devices (SPDs):** Absorb voltage spikes to protect sensitive equipment.

Types of Circuit Breakers

- IP (Single Pole):** Interrupts only the live conductor.
