Use the `mod_num` argument to specify a particular module number and display detailed information on that. Connect to the Cisco switch using a console cable or through a remote management interface. Enter the privileged EXEC mode by typing "enable" and providing the enable password if prompted. We connect Moduletek SFP-25G-SR transceiver to Cisco. If you run fiber or copper uplinks in a small office, home lab, or data closet, SFPs (and SFP+) are the little parts that keep your links alive.
