Follow immediately with a dry lint-free wipe to remove any remaining alcohol and residue. Avoid soaking the connector to prevent streaking or residue buildup.

Step 5: Reinspect the Connector

Use the fiber optic microscope to verify that the connector is free of dust, oil, or debris. If contaminants remain, repeat the cleaning process until the connector is clean.

Step 6: Reconnect and Test

Once clean, carefully reconnect the fiber optic cable to the adapter or transceiver. Use a fiber optic tester to ensure signal integrity and confirm that cleaning has restored optimal performance.
