Types of Galvanized Cable Trays

Pre-Galvanized (PG) Cable Trays
Made from steel sheets coated with zinc before fabrication. Coating thickness typically ranges from 12 to 20 microns (Z120-Z275). Suitable for dry indoor environments such as offices, factories, and warehouses. Economical and polished, but less resistant to outdoor moisture and corrosion, with rust potentially appearing within 6–12 months if used outdoors.

Hot-Dip Galvanized (HDG) Cable Trays
Steel trays are fully dipped in molten zinc, covering all edges, holes, and corners. Coating thickness ranges from 65 to 85 microns, providing long-term corrosion resistance for over 20 years. Ideal for outdoor use, coastal areas, or high-moisture environments. More expensive but ensures durability and safety in harsh conditions.

GI Cable Trays
Galvanized steel trays produced using general galvanization methods. Often used interchangeably with pre-galvanized trays but may vary in coating thickness and application suitability.

Styles and Configurations

Perforated Cable Trays: Feature holes for ventilation and drainage, suitable for medium to heavy cable loads.

Cable Trunking: Enclosed trays for added protection against dust, moisture, or mechanical damage.

Ladders and Wire Mesh Trays: Provide high load capacity and flexibility for complex cable routing.

Load Capacity and Standards
Cable trays must support the weight of cables without failure. Load capacity depends on support span (distance between brackets); doubling the span reduces weight capacity to approximately 25% of the original. Strength and safety are tested according to IEC 61537 or NEMA VE 1 standards.
