

Connect fiber optic transceiver to ring network switch

Step 4: Configure the Ring Network

Ring topology: Each switch in the ring connects to two neighboring nodes, forming a closed loop.

Redundancy and protection: Implement ring protection protocols such as ERPS (Ethernet Ring Protection Switching) or APS (Automatic Protection Switching) to ensure traffic reroutes automatically if a link fails.

VLANs and segmentation: If multiple networks share the ring, configure VLANs or VRFs to isolate traffic and maintain security.
