

# Connect the fiber optic interface to the switch

Terminate the cable with LC connectors (most common) or other compatible connectors like SC or MTP/MPO depending on your transceiver. Pre-terminated cables save time and reduce installation errors.

**Step 4: Install the Transceiver Module** Carefully insert the transceiver module into the switch port until it clicks securely. Avoid touching the optical interface to prevent contamination.

**Step 5: Connect the Fiber Cable** Attach the fiber cable to the transceiver module: Ensure send (TX) and receive (RX) strands are correctly aligned between devices (TX on one end connects to RX on the other) Clean the fiber ends with a fiber cleaning tool to prevent signal loss

**Step 6: Connect the Other End** Plug the other end of the fiber cable into the corresponding transceiver on the second switch, router, or media converter. Verify that the port LEDs indicate a successful link.

**Step 7: Configure the Switch** Adjust the switch port settings if necessary: Set the correct speed and duplex mode Enable link aggregation if using multiple fiber links for higher band...
