

Connect the fiber optic port directly to the router

- Power on the router:** Wait for the indicator lights to confirm the connection.
- Configure the router:** Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (e.g., 192.168.1.1) to verify settings, update firmware, or adjust WAN/DHCP settings as required by your ISP.

Notes and Tips

- Direct fiber connection** is only possible if your router has a compatible SFP/PON port; otherwise, the ONT is mandatory.
- Placement:** Keep the ONT and router near power outlets and in a dry, ventilated area.
- Cable quality:** Use high-quality Ethernet cables (Cat6a or higher) to maintain fiber speeds.
- Troubleshooting:** Check that connectors are clean, properly seated, and that the O...
