- 4. Secure the Busbar** Ensure the busbar itself is firmly mounted using support brackets or insulators to prevent movement. Aluminum busbars may require conductive grease to prevent oxidation and maintain conductivity.
- 5. Insulate and Protect** Install insulation covers over the busbar and connection points. Use heat shrink tubing or electrical tape for additional protection to prevent accidental contact and short circuits.
- 6. Verify the Connection** Double-check all connections for tightness and compliance with electrical standards. Use a multimeter to test continuity and proper voltage distribution. Inspect visually for secure mounting and absence of loose strands or exposed conductors.
- 7. Restore Power and Monitor** Once all connections...

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Use copper bars (numbered 04-06) to connect the busbar components (numbered 02 and 03). Before installation, remove the screws that are partially tightened from the busbar component.
