Proper sizing of the plenum relative to the grille is important because grilles have low air resistance compared to the ductwork, and incorrect sizing can lead to noise or uneven airflow. Low-velocity stub ducts or direct plenum connections are recommended to maintain efficiency and minimize noise. Installation Notes Ensure the grille is detachable for access to the plenum's measurement and adjustment modules. Maintain recommended upstream distances from the plenum to ensure reliable airflow measurement. Use appropriate fasteners or spring clips to se...
