- T-Junctions and Crosses:** Used where multiple trays intersect, enabling branching of cables to different directions while maintaining support.
- Support Hardware:** Hangers, threaded rods, and brackets secure trays to walls, ceilings, or floors. Maximum support spacing is generally 3.6 meters, with load capacities ranging from 318 kg to 340 kg per hanger.
- Covers and Guards:** Optional covers protect cables from dust, debris, or electromagnetic interference, especially in vertical runs or exposed areas.

Installation Guidelines

- Alignment:** Ensure horizontal and vertical trays are aligned to avoid cable stress. Use laser levels or string lines to maintain consistent elevation.
- Bend Radius:** Maintain the minimum bend radius for cables at transitions to prevent damage.
- Modular Assembly:** Use modular fittings to allow easy reconfiguration or expansion of the tray system.
- Grounding:** Ensure all metallic trays are properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards.
