Reduce latency: Edge data centers bring data closer to users, improving response times for applications like gaming, streaming, and 5G services. Colocation Data Centers: Rented space for multiple businesses, sharing infrastructure. Cloud Data Centers: Operated by cloud providers like AWS, Google Cloud, and Microsoft Azure, offering scalable computing and storage. Hyperscale Data Centers: Massive facilities designed for large-scale cloud and AI operations, often housing tens of thousands of servers.
