

Distance between cable trays and gas pipes

- Finished Areas:** In walls, ceilings, or floors, non-metallic sheathed cables (NM cable) may run parallel to gas pipes within 2 inches, and perpendicular crossings require at least 1.5 inches of separation.
- Exposed or Industrial Areas:** In basements or open joist spaces, electrical conductors should remain at least 1 inch from gas pipes and preferably run parallel to minimize interference.
- Gas Meters:** Gas meters should be installed at least 1 meter away from electrical meters or devices capable of sparking, with possible reductions if a non-flammable barrier is installed.

Additional Considerations

- Mechanical Protection:** Using metal conduits (EMT or rigid) can allow closer spacing due to added protection and grounding continuity.
- Maintenance Access:** Ensure enough space for inspections and repairs to avoid long downtimes or undetected hazards.
