1. Calculate Total Load: Begin by listing all circuits, including lighting, power outlets, and specialized equipment. 3. Dimension Calculations: For small lighting or power boxes with incoming lines less than 10 mm²: If switches are fewer than 20, width = switch width + 20 mm on each side, height = switch height + 40 mm, depth = maximum switch depth + 10 mm. If switches exceed 20, arrange in two rows, adjusting width and height accordingly. For larger power boxes or when incoming lines exceed 10 mm², account for bending radius of wires and space for first-level terminals. Depth should accommodate the largest breaker or switch plus wiring clearance.
4. Material and Safety Considerations: Distribution boxes are typically made of metal or high-quality plastic. Ensure the box has proper insulation, grounding, and complies with local electrical standards. Include bus bars, neutral and ground bars, and space for isolators or disconnect switches.
5. Installation Planning: Consider wall mounting, embedded installation, and accessibility for maintenance. Leave sufficient space around the box for wiring and future modifications. The bottom of the box is usually installed at a standard height from the floor, depending on local codes.
