

Distribution box installation height from the ground

- Protection from hazards:** Avoid wet areas, corrosive environments, or locations prone to impact or vibration.
- Consistency:** In buildings with multiple boxes, maintain uniform installation heights with minimal deviation (within 10 mm) for aesthetic and operational consistency.
- Maintenance space:** Ensure sufficient clearance around the box for airflow and for two people to work simultaneously if needed.
