Green check: Steady means normal; slow blinking is standby. Red/yellow alert: Steady red = serious fault (stop high - power use); blinking red = minor fault (fix soon); steady yellow = low voltage (avoid high - power); blinking yellow = temporary issue (wait or contact if lasting). Branch Circuit Breakers: Control power to individual circuits (rooms, appliances, outdoor areas).
