Overview

Wall-mounted boxes should be 4. This height makes it easy to reach without bending or stretching. Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches to avoid. The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. This height also safeguards the box from potential. VISUAL DEVICE NOT LESS THAN 90" TO TOP OR 6" BELOW CEILING, WHICH EVER IS HIGHER. 48" TO CENTERLINE OF BOX - NOT MORE THAN 5'-0" FROM EXIT. EXCEPTION: 44" MAXIMUM TO TOP ABOVE COUNTERS WHICH ARE. The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board.
