

Do cable trays need to be painted with fire-retardant paint

- Intumescent Paints:** These paints expand when exposed to heat, providing additional fire protection. While they can improve fire performance, their effectiveness depends on proper testing and compatibility with the cable material . Oil/solvent-based intumescent paints are generally not recommended for LSOH cables .
- Plenum Cables:** Plenum-rated cables should never be painted, as any coating compromises their fire-resistant properties and increases fire risk .

Best Practices

- Use water-based fire-retardant paints for non-plenum cables and cable trays whenever possible .
- Avoid oil-based or solvent-based paints on fire-resistant cables, as they can degrade the sheath and reduce fire performance .
- Document any painting in inspection or service records, and ensure cable markings remain visible or are relabeled to maintain compliance with safety standards .
