Thermal management: Avoid tight cable bundling with high-power devices to prevent overheating; follow TSB-184-A standards for loose bundling. Cable type selection: Use Cat6A for multi-gigabit and PoE++ devices, and SFP+/DAC or fiber for switch-to-swi...
