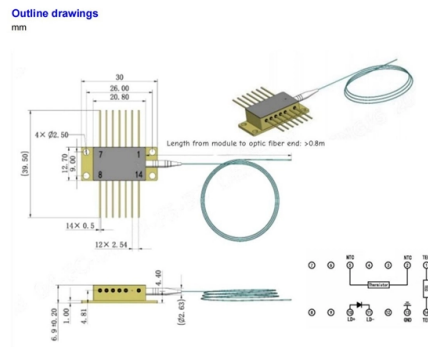


Does BBU need to be connected to a fiber optic cable

- FTTA Hybrid Cables:** Some installations use hybrid fiber-power cables, which combine optical fibers and DC power in a single cable. This reduces tower congestion and simplifies installation.
- Standard Duplex Fiber:** For simpler setups, standard single-mode duplex fiber with SC or LC connectors can be used, often terminated in a fiber distribution box near the RRU for splicing and splitting.

Installation Considerations

- Tower Height and Routing:** Fiber must run from the BBU at the base to the RRU at the top, often over tens to over a hundred meters. Proper cable management, strain relief, and protection against environmental factors are critical.
- Termination and Splicing:** Fiber distribution boxes are used to terminate, splice, and manage fibers, ensuring reliable connections and easy maintenance.
- Signal Integrity:** Using high-quality telecom-grade fiber and connectors ensures minimal attenuation and supports high-bandwidth, low-latency transmission required for 4G and 5G networks.
