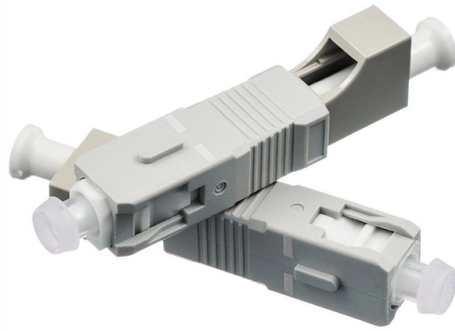

Installation Steps Select a suitable location for the AP with access to power and fiber infrastructure. Connect the Ethernet port from the router or switch to the first media converter. Install the second media converter near the AP and connect it to the AP's Ethernet port. Connect the fiber optic cable between the two media converters, ensuring proper SFP module compatibility. Power the media converters and verify connectivity and signal integrity.
