This IP address is usually. Enterprise LANs use the RJ45 port on 100/1000BASE switches. It connects access layer devices and uplinks from desktop switches or directly to end devices. Once you power up switch, it's basically ready to do its job without any configuration on interfaces, unless it is in Shutdown state. The port type of the 100 M bit/s switches is generally SC card square port, and the optical port type of the 1000 M bit/s switch is generally SFP optical module, and the port type is LC.
