- Customs and Regulatory Compliance** Verify export regulations from Congo and import regulations at the destination country, including any telecom licensing requirements. Prepare commercial invoices, packing lists, and certificates of origin. Some countries may require inspection or certification for high-speed optical equipment.
- Insurance and Risk Management** Insure the shipment for full replacement value, including potential delays or damage. Track the shipment with real-time monitoring to ensure timely delivery.
- Handling Upon Arrival** Inspect the ONU for physical damage and optical alignment before installation. Store in a controlled environment until deployment to prevent degradation.
