- Auxiliary Contacts:** Provide remote monitoring or integration with building management systems.

Installation and Operation

Dual pump switches are typically installed in NEMA-rated enclosures (metal or non-metallic) for protection against dust and moisture. Pumps can be controlled individually or via multi-pump logic, where one pump acts as master and others follow, adjusting speed or starting/stopping based on demand. Float switches or pressure sensors are commonly used to automate pump operation, turning pumps on or off as fluid levels change.
