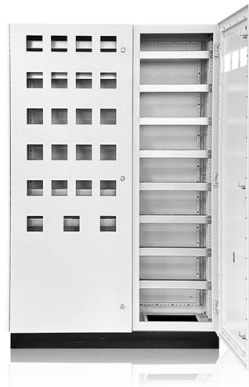


Dual-speed fan control circuit distribution box
