

Easy installation of distribution box baffles



Overview

Fit braces using clips, align clips with the notches in box baffle. 1x Complete box baffle, repeat steps for all baffles. Thread each Box Baffle onto the square crossrunners. Note: assembly order and spacing is not pre-determined, please refer to general assembly drawing. In this video, we walk you through the suspended installation process, from folding the baffles to fine-tuning the suspension hardware for a perfect fini. REFERENCE DETAIL (SUPPLIED FOR WOOD ANCHORING ONLY). FOR ALL OTHER SUBSTRATES, STUDS/ANCHORS MUST BE SOURCED BY THE INSTALLER. IDENTIFY THE THREADED END OF THE BARREL AND THE SWAGE END OF THE WIRE.

*Above arrangement is for reference only to show an assembled system. 2) Determine the suspension points for the Box. There are well established industry rules and guidelines (such as API guides, Shell DEP's and NORSOK Standards) for the design of new separators and inlet/outlet devices when it comes to feed inlet and gas/liquid outlet velocity and momentum.
