The electric distribution box at a residence entrance is the service entrance equipment, including the meter and main service panel, which safely receives and distributes electricity from the utility to the home. Components and Function

The service entrance is the point where electricity from the utility company enters a home. It typically consists of:

- Electric Meter:** Housed in a meter base, this device measures the total energy consumption of the residence in kilowatt-hours for billing purposes. The meter is usually removable by the utility, but the surrounding enclosure is the homeowner's responsibility.
- Service Panel (Breaker Box or Load Center):** Contains the main circuit breaker, which acts as the primary disconnect for all power entering the home, and individual circuit breakers that protect branch circuits throughout the house.
- Service Drop:** The overhead or underground connection from the utility lines to the home. Overhead service drops often include two hot wires and one neutral wire, providing 120/240V service.
- Weatherhead and Service Mast:** For overhead connections, a weatherhead protects the conductors from rain and snow, while the service mast (rigid conduit) guides the wires down to the meter base.

Electrical Flow Electricity flows from the utility's distribution lines, often stepped down by a transformer, through the service drop to the weatherhead and service mast. It then passes through the electric meter and into the main service panel, where the two hot wires connect to the main breaker and the neutral wire connects to the neutral busbar. The grounding system bonds the neutral busbar to a grounding electrode, typically metal rods driven into the earth, ensuring safety.

Safety and Maintenance The main breaker allows the entire home to be disconnected in emergencies or for maintenance. Proper grounding and correct wire sizing are es...
