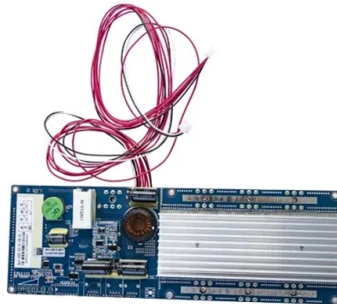


Electrocuted by flooded electrical box
